About the Role

You will be working on a daily basis to help ensure the smooth running of our Reading warehouse. This is a hands-on role, that will give you a fantastic grounding in the AV industry.

No day is the same and you will be ensuring that equipment and resources are prepared and tested ready for our clients hiring equipment. Liaising with them on collection and return, and troubleshooting where needed.

A normal day will include:

- Preparing hires and testing to company standards.
- Ensuring all equipment upon leaving and returning to the warehouse is tested, checked in and out correctly and on-time.
- Providing excellent customer service to our customers when they arrive to collect or return equipment they have hired.
- Assisting the Engineering team with loading and unloading equipment from trucks.
- Performing basic repairs on equipment, in liaison with the Maintenance Engineer
- Keeping the Warehouse and its surrounding areas a clean and safe environment to work.
- Preparing the equipment for training courses that we regularly offer.
- Receiving and preparing subhires for return, checking and testing equipment as it arrives, and ensuring equipment is complete upon return.
